Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.78 dated 01.06.2016 under Sections 419/420/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City-1, Malerkotla

This Court vide order dated 08.09.2016, while issuing notice of motion, has granted ad-interim bail to the petitioner subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/ Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 08.09.2016, petitioner has joined the investigation. He further states that since the matter has been compromised between the petitioner and the complainant, a quashing petition bearing CRM-M-39842-2016 on the basis of compromise has already been filed by the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instruction from ASI Major Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and submits that in terms of order 08.09.2016, petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 08.09.2016 are made absolute.

However, petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
