This is petition under Section 439 of Cr. P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 08 dated 30.01.2016 registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Sadar Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

It is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. The petitioner is in custody since 30.01.2016.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel states that the quantity recovered from the petitioner is commercial in nature.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the case file.

Keeping in view the fact that the quantity recovered from the petitioner is commercial in nature, no ground for grant of concession of bail is made out. Consequently, the petition is dismissed.
