Petitioner seeks concession of pre-arrest bail claiming that he absented on 22.8.2016 and moved an application for exemption from personal appearance which was disallowed.

I have heard the counsel for the petitioner and gone through the record. The petitioner had been granted the concession of interim bail till the receipt of report of chemical examiner in a case of recovery of 1140 tablets of alprazolam. The report of chemical examiner was received on 21.7.2016 and the challan was presented in the present case on 24.9.2015 prior to the receipt of said report. Since the petitioner had been granted conditional bail till the receipt of report of chemical examiner, he was required to comply with the directions and surrender before the Court and seek concession of regular bail but he had evaded appearance before the trial Court by filing application for exemption from personal appearance. I do not find any ground to grant the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

The petition is dismissed. The petitioner is directed to comply with the interim order and put in appearance before the trial Court. In case, he surrenders before the trial Court within a period of 10 days and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same may be considered in accordance with law within a period of 10 days.
