Petitioner seeks the benefit of regular bail in case F.I.R. No.156 dated 30.5.2015 under sections 22, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S Act, registered at Police Station, Tripri Town, District Patiala.

As per prosecution version the alleged recovery is of 1100 tablets of Allied brand.

Petitioner was arrested on 30.5.2015.

It has gone uncontroverted that samples having been sent, report of the Chemical Examiner is still awaited.

Under such circumstances, the issue with regard to offence being made out against the present petitioner under the N.D.P.S Act would still be open.

In view of the above circumstances, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of interim bail. Petitioner be released on interim bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Patiala.

It is, however, clarified that upon receipt of the report of the Chemical Examiner, if, an offence is made out against the present petitioner, he would be taken into custody forth with.
