Heard Learned Counsel for the rival parties in FIR No.31, which was registered on 17.5.2016 at Police Station Behrampur, District Gurdaspur for the offences under Sections 376, 420 IPC. Admittedly, both the petitioner as well as the victim were major. The case of the prosecution itself is that the victim had affair with the petitioner for a period of over two years and the petitioner having refused to marry her, as promised, she lodged the FIR. In that view of the matter, there is prima facie case for grant of bail to the petitioner. In that view of the matter, bail is granted to the petitioner on such terms and conditions as may be deemed fit by the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
