Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the court of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar to dispose of the trial in case FIR No.258 dated 04.07.2009, under Sections 419, 420, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar City, within a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioners restricts his prayer to the extent that trial Court may be directed for expeditious disposal of the case.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and gone through the record.

Perusal of zimni orders annexed with the file shows that trial Court is exempting personal appearances of accused in a

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routine/casual manner which causes unnecessary delay in the disposal of the case. In such circumstances, the trial Court is directed to dispose of the case expeditiously in accordance with law. It is made clear that only in case of hardship or reasonable ground, personal appearance of the accused is to be exempted, not in routine/casual manner.

Disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
