Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in complaint case No.1272 dated 27.11.2014 titled as “Prince Versus Ajaypal Singh” under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner being a labourer could not arrange the sureties, but now, he has appeared before the trial Court and has been admitted on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. In support of his contention, he has produced certified copy of order dated 18.10.2016 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar. The same is taken on record.
