The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 10.04.2015,
for having been found in possession of 75 bottles of intoxicant
liquid, containing codeine phosphate.

This is second application of the petitioner for regular
bail.

As per learned counsel for the petitioner, only one
witness has been examined, while on the instructions of Head
Constable Manjit Singh, it has been informed that five witnesses

have been examined, out of eighteen.

Without expression of any opinion on merits, this petition is disposed of with a direction that the trial Court shall conclude the entire prosecution evidence, by giving short dates of hearing, within a period of five months after the next date of hearing.

It is ordered that in case, all the prosecution witnesses are not examined within a period of five months after the next date of hearing, the trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.
