JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioners Karanbir Singh & Charan Singh have sought pre-arrest feeling apprehension of their arrest in case FIR No. 3, dated January 19, 2016, under Sections 336, 427 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar, during the pendency of trial.

At the time of issuance of notice of motion on September 09, 2016, following order was passed:

“Notice of motion for 26.10.2016.

In the meanwhile, petitioners are directed to join the investigation. In the event of arrest, petitioners shall be released on interim bail at the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

At this stage, Mr. Abhimanyu Vinayak, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2.”

On instructions from H.C. Jaswinder Singh, Learned State counsel has submitted that in compliance of order dated September 09, 2016 petitioners have already joined the investigation before the trial Court and they are no more required for further interrogation.

Accordingly, order dated September 09, 2016 is made absolute and shall enure during the pendency of trial.

However, petitioners shall abide by all the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
