This petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.13 dated 21.08.2015 registered under Sections 406/498-A IPC at Police Station NRI (Cell), Phase-7, Mohali.

While issuing notice of motion on 11.09.2015, the interim protection was granted to the petitioners. Subsequently, during pendency of the proceedings, the matter between the parties was settled before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. The factum of said compromise has been affirmed by learned counsel for respondent No.2.

The statements of the parties recorded before the Mediator are also on

record.

Since the dispute between the parties has been settled and moreover, it is a matrimonial dispute, therefore, no purpose would be served in case proceedings are continued.

Accordingly, the interim direction issued by this Court on 11.09.2015 is made absolute.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
