The petitioner seeks the concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Divya Rani, alleging that the petitioner, not only gave her beatings, but also forced her to leave the house. On her refusal to obey the command of the petitioner, he along with three other persons allegedly strangled the complainant and thrown her in the canal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn attention

of this Court to the marriage deed (Annexure P-3) of one Ranveer Singh with the complainant and their marriage certificate (Annexure P-2); and a Panchayati Divorce (Annexure P-4), dated 05.04.2016, of the petitioner and the complainant.

Without expression of any opinion on merits, it is sufficient to observe that the challan has already been presented and the petitioner has been in custody, w.e.f. 04.06.2016, he can be granted the concession of bail.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
