The petitioner, allegedly exhorted his co-accused, who attacked the complainant, namely Sukhjinder Singh. He had been released on bail earlier, but the offence under Section 308 I.P.C. having been converted into Section 307 I.P.C., he was again taken into custody. He has been in custody, w.e.f. 04.03.2016.

Since the injuries are attributed to the co-accused of the petitioner, he can be granted the concession of bail.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
