In view of commercial quantity of poppy husk having been recovered from the petitioner, it is immaterial that he has been in custody with effect from 25.09.2015, especially, when he has been convicted in another case of recovery of commercial quantity of poppy husk. The bail application is dismissed in view of provisions of Section 37 of the NDPS Act.

However, in view of the fact that no witness has been examined till date, a direction is given to the prosecution agency to expeditiously produce the witnesses with a simultaneous direction to the trial Court to give short dates of hearing in the interest of concluding the case within a period of maximum six months.
