INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.92 dated 23.10.2014, registered at Police Station Jodhan, Ludhiana Rural, Ludhiana, under Section 22 of NDPS Act.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

From the record, I find that as per the order dated 18.07.2016, the present petitioner has already been declared proclaimed offender and challan was adjourned to 22.08.2016 for prosecution evidence under Section 299 Cr.P.C. There is every apprehension that if the petitioner is granted the concession of bail, he may again abscond and misuse the concession of bail. There is no cogent explanation for the absence of the petitioner from the court proceedings.

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The petitioner has absented from the court proceedings and has been declared proclaimed offender, therefore, no ground for the grant of anticipatory bail to him is made out.

Finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
