The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for giving direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to provide protection of life and liberty from respondents No. 4 and 5 and their relatives and for issuing direction to respondent No. 2 to take action on the complaint.

Record of the previous file was also called for. Earlier the petitioner had approached this Court and in the joint petition filed alongwith Jaspal Singh, she had pleaded that she was major and had married Jagpal. Copy of the Aadhar Card and photographs were also placed on record and they were granted protection.

The petitioner was asked to be present in the Court. She states that she had not consented to the marriage and it was out of fear that she had jointly filed the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that she would be satisfied if directions are given to the SHO to dispose of the complaint

The petitioner claims that she was under a threat. She has a remedy of filing complaint. It is stated that complaint was given to the SHO concerned.

Considering the averments made in the petition, the same is disposed of and the petitioner is directed to approach the SSP concerned and file a representation. The SSP, Bathinda would dispose of the petition at his own level in accordance with law.
