As a member of unlawful assembly, the petitioner is alleged to have assaulted the complainant, namely Sanjeev Sharma. Out of 21 accused persons, 4 persons have been granted the concession of bail. The petitioner was seen in the C.C.T.V. footage to have participated as a member of unlawful assembly, however, no specific injury is attributed to him. He has been in custody, w.e.f. 15.06.2016.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is

ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
