Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to register the case into the murder of son of the petitioner, namely, Sarvesh in Chandigarh. Further prayer has also been made to handover the investigation to independent agency like CBI.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that initially, the petitioner has projected his case that his son, namely, Sarvesh has been murdered in Chandigarh and he has complained about the same and medical report is also indicating towards a murder, the police has closed the case by writing a false statement of the petitioner.

Reply dated 07.07.2015 by way of affidavit of Sohan Singh, Sub-Inspector, Police Station, Sector-11, Chandigarh on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 has already been filed in the Court. Along with the said reply Examination Report of CFSL, Sector 36-A, Chandigarh as Annexure R-1, Histopathology Examination Report as Annexure R-2 as well as report as to cause of death as Annexure R-3 have also been filed in the Court.

The relevant portion of annexure R-3 (report as to cause of death), reads as under:-

"After seeing histopathology & CFSL report, the cause of death is cardio respiratory arrest as a result of Pulmonary odema."

In view of the reply as well as Histopathology Examination Report (Annexure R-2), no further orders are required to be passed in the present case, as the cause of death is fully detailed in the report (Annexure R-3).

Thus, no case for interference is made out and the present petition is disposed of in the light of Histopathology Examination Report (Annexure R-2).
