By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioners have sought pre-arrest bail in case FIR No. 244, dated 17.07.2016, under Sections 307, 323, 341, 148 and 149, registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

At the time of issuance of notice of motion on September 09, 2016, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Inter-alia, it has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that no specific injury has been attributed to the petitioners. Moreover, the injuries suffered by the complainant/injured fall within the ambit of Section 323 of IPC only. Injury No.2 was subjected to CT Scan and it has been found to be simple in nature as no fracture was seen. Moreover, Harjit Singh and Sonu who were similarly situated have been granted the concession of interim bail by this Court vide order dated September 06, 2016 passed in CRM No.M-31343 of 2016.

Notice of motion for 24.10.2016.

In the meanwhile, petitioners are directed to join the investigation. In the event of arrest, petitioners shall be released on interim bail at the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Diwan Singh, has candidly submits that in compliance of afore-said order, petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.

In view of above, order dated September 09, 2016 is hereby, made absolute and shall enure during the pendency of trial.

However, petitioners shall abide by all the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
