Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Sanjay Sudhir in case FIR No.100 dated 20.05.2015 for offence punishable under Section 408 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar.

The petitioner is employed as a Manager in the godown of M/s Harbir Automobiles. A consignment of 61 vehicles was received from Mahindra and Mahindra company through a transporter complainant firm i.e. Dayal Logistics. However, one Bolero with specific number is also alleged to have been dispatched but not received in the stock of M/s Harbir Automobiles.

On suspicion name of the petitioner has surfaced.

It was contended on behalf of the petitioner that he was not responsible for inspection at the time of receipt and however, as per records only 60 vehicles had been received.

He submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ajit Singh concedes that the petitioner has joined investigation and is longer required for custodial interrogation. Even otherwise untrace report has been prepared.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 21<sup>st</sup> of September, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
