The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.3, dated 20.1.2016, registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of the IPC, at Police Station Lambra, Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has now been in custody since 11.2.2016 and the other co-accused are on bail and this is a case of Magisterial trial.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab, on instructions from SI Satpal,

Has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.
