JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

Through the instant petition preferred under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioners-Resham Singh and others have sought pre-arrest bail, feeling apprehension of their arrest, in case bearing FIR No.85, dated 01.07.2016, under Sections 336, 506, 34 IPC and Section 25/27 of the Arms Act, Police Station Ghall Khurd, District Ferozepur.

2. At the time of issuance of notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 09.09.2016:-

“It is inter alia contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners have been falsely implicated in the instant case. It is a no injury case. Moreover, no empty cartridge was recovered from the spot. Notice of motion for 27.10.2016.

Meanwhile, petitioners are directed to join the investigation. In the event of arrest, petitioners shall be

released on pre-arrest bail at the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer subject to the conditions, as envisaged under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Palwinder Sngh, Police Station Ghall Khurd, District Ferozepur has clearly pointed out that in compliance of order dated 09.09.2016, the petitioners have already joined the investigation and are no more required for further investigation.

4. Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits, the petition is allowed and order dated 09.09.2016 is made absolute and shall enure during the pendency of trial but subject to the conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
