JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J. (Oral)

The instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.107 dated 01.10.2015, registered under Sections 323, 325, 452, 307 and 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at P.S. Rori, Distt. Sirsa.

Contends that no injury has been attributed to the petitioner. The allegation against the petitioner is that he supplied country-made pistol to Harbans Singh, who is the husband of sister-in-law of the complainant. The complainant and all other material witnesses have already been examined. The petitioner is in custody since 28.10.2015.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has opposed the present petition on the ground that the petitioner has supplied illegal arms to co-accused Harbans Singh. Out of twenty one witnesses, eight have already

been examined.

Heard.

The petitioner is in custody since 28.10.2015. No injury has been attributed to him. Out of twenty one prosecution witnesses, only eight have been examined so far, therefore, it can safely be inferred that the trial is not likely to be concluded in the near future. The material witnesses already stand examined.

Keeping in view the above, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

However, anything observed hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion, on the merits of the case.
