Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.369 dated 15.10.2015 under Sections 302 and 365 read with Section 34 IPC (Sections 342, 364 and 368 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station A/Division, District Amritsar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh, states that trial in the case is at advance stage as out of total 19 prosecution witnesses, 14 have already been examined. 4 witnesses have been given up and only 1 witness i.e. the investigating officer is to be examined.

In view of the advance stage of the trial and the fact that only 1

witness i.e. the investigating officer is to be examined by the prosecution, no ground for grant of regular bail to the petitioner is made out.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
