Reply filed by the State, is taken on record.

Quashing of FIR No. 272 dated 29.07.2013 under Sections 406/498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Mahesh Nagar, Ambala, is being sought on the basis of compromise deed dated 01.12.2015 (P-2)

Respondent No. 2 got married to petitioner on 20.04.2008. Due to temperamental differences, both the parties could not live together as husband and wife. The relationship between them became strained and thereafter, the F.I.R was registered against the petitioner on account of bringing less dowry and harassment caused by the petitioner

However, the matter has now been duly compromised, vide compromise deed dated 01.12.2015 (P-2)

In compliance of order dated 14.09.2016, report dated 28.09.2016 of Judl. Magistrate 1st Class, Ambala, has been received in this regard. As per report, joint statement of parties have been recorded. They

stated that the matter stands compromised between the parties and the complainant does not want to proceed further against the accused and has no objection, if the present F.I.R be quashed against the petitioner. The compromise has been entered voluntarily.

Consequently, in view of the status report dated 28.09.2016 and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Dr. Arvind Barsaul etc. versus State of Madhya Pradesh and another 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 910***, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No. 272 dated 29.07.2013 under Sections 406/498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Mahesh Nagar, Ambala, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioner.

The petition stands disposed of.
