JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner in case FIR No.36 dated 16.04.2015, under Sections 326, 324, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station City Batala, Police District Batala, Gurdaspur.

As per the allegations, the petitioner had inflicted a *Datar* blow to Ashwani Kumar on his left wrist and also raised *lalkara*.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Shivinder Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation on a number of occasions, however, he has not co-operated in the recovery of said *Datar*.

The injury on the left wrist of Ashwani Kumar has been opined to be grievous in nature.

In the light of the non-cooperative attitude, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
