2. At the asking of the Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to learned State counsel.

3. This is a petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of order dated 30.04.2002 passed by Id. Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar in FIR No. 67 dated 10.08.1996, under Sections 307, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25/27 of the Arms Act, Police Station Kathu Nangal, District Amritsar (Rural), Punjab, vide which, the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to surrender before trial Court to face trial, in case, some sort of protection is provided to him by allowing him bail by the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate by keeping the

operation of order dated 30.04.2002 (Annexure P-5) in abeyance.

5. Accordingly, instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before trial Court within a week to face trial and in case he applies for bail, that should be allowed by the trial Court at its satisfaction.
