Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR
No.106 dated 24.12.2015 under Sections 323, 324, 506, 34 IPC and
(326 IPC added later on), PS Haryana, District Hoshiarpur.

As per allegations, petitioner alongwith his two
companions waylaid complainant Ram Chand on 20.12.2015 at
around 11 am and thereafter said two companions gave fist blows
and kicks to the complainant. Role attributed to the petitioner is that
he caused a *datar* blow on the left leg (below knee) of the
complainant.

It is contended that petitioner was earlier released on bail

after he having joined investigation and the said concession was never misused. Subsequently, offence under Section 326 IPC has been added and therefore, no useful purpose would be served by again arresting the petitioner. It is further submitted that petitioner is involved in no other case.

It is next contended that the petitioner has joined investigation and fully cooperated.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh, concedes that the petitioner has joined investigation, recovery has been effected and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, anticipatory bail granted vide order dated 29.01.2016 is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
