Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner-Gurmail Kaur @ Melo in case registered by way of FIR No.112 dated 13.08.2016 at Police Station Doraha, District Ludhiana under Sections 306 and 120-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of orders of interim bail dated 14th September, 2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Jagtar Singh, Police Station Doraha, District Ludhiana who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from her and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order

dated 14th September, 2016 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
