JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Through the instant petition preferred under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioners have sought bail in case bearing FIR No.382 dated 12.07.2016, under Sections 399, 402 IPC, registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Faridabad.

Briefly stated the case of the prosecution is that on receipt of a secret information, petitioners along with their co-accused, namely, Parkash, Sher Singh and Mahesh were apprehended by the police from an isolated place i.e. road between bus stand NH 2 to Nahar Singh Stadium, Faridabad where they were planning to commit dacoity in the show room of NH 1 Market, Faridabad in the wee hours on 12.07.2016. At the time of arrest of the petitioners, iron rods are alleged to have been recovered from them. Moreover, the co-accused of the petitioners, namely, Sher Singh and Parkash have already been granted the concession of bail by the Sessions Court as well as by this Court, respectively. After completion of the investigation, report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C., has also been presented. The conclusion of the trial is not possible within a short span of time and would certainly take sufficient long time.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on merits, petition is allowed and both the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing requisite bonds at the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
