TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.126 dated 28.07.2015, under Sections 323/342/34 IPC (Sections 365/325 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Dehlon, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana City.

On 14.12.2015, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.126 dated 28.7.2015, under Sections 323, 342 read with Section 34 IPC (subsequently added Sections 365 and 325 IPC), registered at Police Station Dehlon, District Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh submits that during the investigation the offence under Section 365 IPC has been deleted. However, petitioners are required to join the investigation for the remaining offences i.e. under Sections 323, 342 and 325 read with Section 34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are ready to join the investigation.

Accordingly, the petitioners are directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 22.12.2015 at 11.00 AM and join the investigation. In the event of their arrest, they be admitted to interim bail by the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer to his satisfaction. They shall, however, abide by all the conditions as envisaged by Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Adjourned to 18.3.2016.”

Learned State counsel would apprise the Court that the petitioners have since joined investigation.

Prayer is allowed. Order dated 14.12.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.
