Quashing of FIR No.93 dated 05.10.2013, under Sections 354 IPC registered at Police Station, Nur Pur Bedi, Anandpur Sahib District Ropar (Annexure P-1) is sought on the basis of compromise dated 05.09.2016 (Annexure P-2).

The FIR was registered on the basis of statement made by Harpreet Kaur-respondent No.2 alleging that on 04.10.2013, at about 9.30 A.M., when she was taking care of corn crop in her court-yard, Gurvinder Singh @ Kaka, who was known to her, came there and said her brother-in-law (Dewar) had asked for meal. When she went to the kitchen, he came behind her and started molesting her with bad intentions. On raising of alarm, he managed to escape from the spot. When her husband came back at home, she narrated whole story to him. In this background, the FIR was got registered.

However, the matter has now been duly compromised, vide compromise dated 05.09.2016 (Annexure P/2). In compliance of order dated 14.09.2016, report dated 31.10.2016 of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sri Anandpur Sahib, has been received in this regard. As per report, statement of parties have been recorded. Complainant stated that the matter

stands compromised between the parties and she does not want to proceed further against the accused and has no objection, if the present F.I.R be quashed against the petitioner. The compromise has been entered voluntarily. To the same effect is the statements given by petitioner.

Consequently, in view of the status report and the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in case *Madan Mohan Abbot Vs. State of Punjab*, 2008 (2) RCR (Criminal) 429, the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in case *Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another*, 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052, this Court is of the view that no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation between the parties.

Accordingly, FIR No.93 dated 05.10.2013, under Sections 354 IPC registered at Police Station, Nur Pur Bedi, Anandpur Sahib District Ropar (Annexure P-1) is quashed with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
