FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The allegations against the petitioner Jeet Singh in this regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. are that on 30.06.2016 his co-accused Bhupinder Kumar was apprehended by the Police leading to recovery of 4.5 Kg. of opium and 4Kg. of poppy husk and it is on the basis of his confession the name of the present petitioner has cropped up in the investigations .

The contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner that there is no semblance of evidence against the petitioner and nothing has been recovered from him and that he is in custody since 11.6.2016. have not been controverted by learned State counsel.

Keeping in view the legality, validity and acceptability

of the statement of the accused is a debatable issue and keeping in view the custody period of the petitioner and that trial is not likely to be concluded in near future and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars, without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
