This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.100 dated 08.12.2014, registered under Sections 21, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Division No.3, Ludhiana City.

Learned counsel states that the petitioner was regularly

appearing before the trial Court and he was granted the concession of
