Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.104 dated 29.08.2016, registered at Police Station Amargarh District Sangrur, under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the instant petition qua petitioner No.3 Jaspreet Singh but liberty may be granted to him to surrender before the Competent Court and move an application for grant of regular bail and a direction may be issued to the Court to decide the said application expeditiously.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands dismissed as withdrawn qua petitioner No.3 Jaspreet Singh. In case, he surrenders before the

Competent Court on 28.09.2016 and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same shall be decided expeditiously by the learned trial Court but in any case on or before 30.09.2016.

As regards petitioner Nos.1 and 2, learned counsel for the petitioners argued that both the said petitioners are old persons and they have been involved in the instant case as they are members of the family.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sadha Singh, has accepted the said factual assertions.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the prayer made by petitioner Nos.1 and 2.

Accordingly, the instant petition qua petitioner Nos.1 and 2 stands allowed. Petitioner Nos.1 and 2 are directed to appear before the concerned Investigating Officer on 30.09.2016 between 10.00 am. to 04.00 p.m. and on any other day when concerned Investigating Officer requires their presence and would otherwise cooperate with him/her. On appearance, petitioner Nos.1 and 2 be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, they shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
