Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.55 dated 19.07.2016, registered at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 341, 148/149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later).

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the instant petition qua petitioner No.1 Balram Singh but liberty may be granted to him to surrender before the Competent Court and move an application for grant of regular bail and a direction may be issued to the Court to decide the said application expeditiously.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands dismissed as withdrawn qua petitioner No.1 Balram Singh. In case, he surrenders before the Competent Court on 28.09.2016 and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same shall be decided expeditiously by the learned trial

Court but in any case on or before 30.09.2016.

As regards petitioner No.2 Gopal Singh, learned counsel for the petitioners argued that the injury attributed to petitioner No.2 is simple in nature.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Jagjit Singh, has accepted the said factual assertion.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the prayer made by petitioner No.2.

Accordingly, the instant petition qua petitioner No.2 stands allowed. Petitioner No.2 is directed to appear before the concerned Investigating Officer on 30.09.2016 between 10.00 am. to 04.00 p.m. and on any other day when concerned Investigating Officer requires his presence and would otherwise cooperate with him/her. On appearance, the petitioner No.2 be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, he shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C
