By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.165 dated 20.10.2014, registered under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Division No.7 (Vardhman), Ludhiana.

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 14.09.2016, the petitioner has appeared and furnished bail/surety bonds before the trial Court.

The learned State counsel does not controvert the above said fact.
