INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.140 dated 29.12.2014, registered at Police Station Ramdas, District Amritsar Rural, under Sections 324 and 34 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added subsequently).

Notice of motion has been issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that grievous injury under Section 326 IPC has been attributed to non-petitioner/Joginder Singh. The present petitioner is stated to be armed with *datar* and has given its blow from the

reverse side on the forehead above left eye brow of the complainant.

All the offences are triable by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class. The petitioner has been in custody since 01.06.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
