The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking bail in FIR No.232 dated 05.06.2016 registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Sector 17, Chandigarh.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioners No.1 and 2 were arrested on 07.06.2016 and 05.06.2016 respectively and since then they are in jail. Admittedly, the challan has been filed before the competent court. The offence is triable by the Magistrate. The trial will take its own time. The petitioners are students and looking to their age I think there is no point in continuing the detention of the petitioners.

In that view of the matter, the bail petition is allowed.

Petitioners be released on bail subject to the terms and conditions as may

be fixed by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
