The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.92,
dated 19.4.2015, registered under Sections 22, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act,
at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur.

On the last date, the following order was passed:-

“ The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail.
Learned counsel for the petitioner states that
recovery is of 1080 tablets of Alprazolam and the
petitioner has been in custody since 19.04.2015.

Learned Additional Advocate General states
that since recovery is of commercial quantity it would

be appropriate to put a time cap on the trial and as per her only 5 official witnesses remain to be examined and prays for an adjournment to file statement of the Senior Superintendent of Police Ferozepur to the effect that the prosecution will conclude its entire evidence on or before 23.12.2016 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.

Adjourned to 09.12.2016.”

Learned Addl. AG Punjab states that though the affidavit has not been received by her but she has instructions to state that the prosecution will conclude the entire evidence on or before 23.12.2016 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.

Keeping in view the statement of counsel for the respondent, I dismiss these petitions at this stage but direct the trial Court to release the petitioner on bail in case the prosecution fails to conclude the evidence on or before 23.12.2016 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.
