INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.12 dated 05.03.2015, registered at Police Station Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 326-A, 506, 34, 379, 419, 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 6 of the Poisons Act, 1991.

Notice of motion. On the asking of Court, Ms. Shivali, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record. Police record has also been produced.

As per the allegations of the prosecution, two boys were standing on a black colour Splendor motor-cycle about 25-30 yards away

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from the house of complainant-Rajwinder Kaur, who is aged about 17 years and studying in 12th standard in Govt. Senior Secondary School (Girls). One of the boys was holding a glass utensil in his hand and he threw acid from the said utensil on the complainant which fell on her face, neck and shoulder. Due to this, skin of complainant started burning and when she raised alarm, those boys fled away from the spot. As per the allegations, the present petitioner is one of the accused who was driving the vehicle.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.

However, as the petitioner has been in custody since 05.03.2015, therefore, trial Court is directed to expedite the trial by giving short adjournments or by adjourning the case on day to day basis, if requires.
