The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.247, dated 4.8.2016, registered under Sections 420, 120-B of the IPC, at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the real main accused is the husband of the petitioner and he is in custody. The petitioner has been implicated being his wife and had a joint account with him. The petitioner has now been in custody for the last 25 days.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab, on instructions, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, Mohali.

Petition stands disposed of.
