ANITA CHAUDHRY, J. (ORAL)

Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 61 dated 09.07.2015 under Sections 406/498-A of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 16.09.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated.

Learned State counsel on instructions has stated that the petitioner has joined investigation. He further states that the complainant has not handed over bills to the police.

Custodial interrogation is not necessary to effect recovery. Recovery can otherwise be effected.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 16.09.2015 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub-Section 2 Clause (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
