FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 20.02.2016 sent by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Angrez Singh, Kulwinder Kaur and Nishan Singh as well as of complainant Baljinder Kaur it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the parties are neighbours and have effected a compromise for offences which are not heinous and which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052,** FIR

No.247 dated 22.09.2009 under Sections 3(1) of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 Police Station, Focal Point, Ludhiana and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
