Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Vishal Poonia in case FIR No.100 dated 8.2.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 147, 149, 201, 323, 506, 406, 420, 447, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Sadar, Hisar.

The petitioner admittedly was the elected president of Group Housing Society since 12.12.2012. During investigation it is surfaced that during his presidentship, the shop-cum-flat has been sold to four different people and the certificates have been issued under his signatures.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that even his signatures have been forged by someone. The certificates have not been issued by the society and except one in favour of Mohit Rathee. He has also denied his signatures on all the certificates.

Learned State Counsel assisted by SI Chatter Pal submits that the said certificates are in the possession of the investigating agency and have been found to have been issued by the society. He further submits that on the disclosure statement of the father of the present petitioner, namely, Ishwar Poonia, who is the co-accused, it has been specifically stated that his son Vishal Poonia (present petitioner) along with one Anup an employee were engaged in selling the same plot over and over again.

Keeping in view the nature of allegations, it is evident that the custodial interrogation would be required to complete the chain of investigations and as such petitioner is not entitled to the grant of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
