Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.114 dated 03.05.2015, under Section 384 IPC registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Bathinda on the basis of compromise.

The FIR was registered at the instance of Jabarjang Singh respondent No.2 alleging that he had received a letter demanding a sum of Rs.3 crores as ransom and was required to arrive at a specific spot.

Statements of the complainant and the petitioners stand recorded by the trial Court that the matter has been compromised. Report has been received in this regard.

Taking into consideration the ratio of judgment in *Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052*, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
