Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.206 dated 22.09.2015, registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, at P.S. Machhiwara, District Ludhiana.

As per the allegations the grandfather of the petitioners had

given what he thought was Special Power of Attorney to his son (father

of the petitioners) for prosecuting some cases which were pending in different Courts. On the strength of that Special Power of Attorney the father of the petitioners got the property of the grandfather transferred in the name of the petitioners.

I find the conduct of the petitioners reprehensible and regret my inability to grant them anticipatory bail.

Petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
