This is the second petition filed by the petitioner seeking regular bail in FIR No. 139 dated 15.05.2015 registered at Police Station Kosli, District Rewai under Sections 328, 304B, 34 IPC

Petitioner is the mother-in-law who is in custody since 03.06.2015 and she seeks parity with Ashok Kumar who had been allowed bail on 02.09.2016 and refers to Annexure P-5.

The petitioner is in custody since 03.06.2015 and 12 witnesses had been examined out of 17 witnesses. No suicide note was left. The girl was pursuing her master's degree. The trial is taking time.

An application had also been filed under Section 319 Cr.P.C. which was later on dismissed.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
