The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.90 dated 18.07.2014, registered under Sections 411, 414, 489-A, 489-B, 489-C, 489-D of the Indian Penal Code; Sections 15, 18, 21 and 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985; Section 25 of the Arms Act; and Section 14 of the Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 1952, at Police Station Sarai Amanat Khan, Distt. Amritsar City.

Heard.

On 16.09.2016, the following order was passed:-

“Petitioners seek concession of pre-arrest bail in case registered on the basis of vague and general allegations.

Co-accused of the petitioners have been granted concession of bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court.

Notice to Advocate General, Punjab for 07.11.2016.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the

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petitioners will join investigation on or before 24.09.2016. In case of petitioners doing so, they will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 16.09.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
