The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR
No.515, dated 4.7.2016, registered under Sections 306/34 of the IPC, at
Police Station Civil Lines, Karnal.

As per allegations, the petitioner owns a transport company

and co-accused Gurnam Singh is the owner of a truck of which the

deceased was a driver. The deceased committed suicide and left behind a note mentioning therein that his employer had not paid his salary for the last one year @ ₹ 12,000/- per month, and as regards the present petitioner, he had borrowed ₹ 50,000/- from him and whenever he asked him to return the money, he used to threaten him and on one occasion had also given him beatings.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that it would be a far fetched situation if every time a borrower refuses to return the money to the lender and the lender commits suicide and the borrower is held guilty for abetment thereof.

Learned Addl. AG Haryana as well as counsel for the complainant have, however, argued that the petitioner was named in the suicide note.

Be that as it may, in the facts and circumstances of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Consequently, petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 6.10.2016 or on any other day on which the Investigating Officer requires his presence, and in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as

contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
