Present petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner/accused-Kayam Hussain in case FIR No.92 dated 11.08.2014, under Sections 22/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (Sections 27A, 29 of the NDPS Act added later on), registered with Police Station City Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

There is a alleged recovery of 90 vials of Rexcof (100 ML each) and 18 strips of Carisoma tablets, which quantity concededly is commercial in nature.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 11.08.2014.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by HC Harbax Singh, submits that entire evidence is over and the case is now listed for arguments on 30.03.2016.

In the light of the fact end of the trial, this Court is not inclined to entertain the present petition for bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed. However, learned trial Court is directed to conclude the trial at the earliest.
